2023 GRANT APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS AND GUIDELINES

FUNDING PRIORITIES/FOCUS AREAS

- **Health and Wellness** - (i.e. new or existing programs or projects, focused on improving physical and mental health, substance abuse resources, environmental/community programs or projects that specifically promote health, wellness and/or healing, etc.)
- **Education** - (i.e. new or existing programs or projects to improve literacy, graduation rates, overall student success, adult/senior education resources, educational technology, community educational resources/outreach programs, etc.)
- **Emergency Assistance** - (i.e. new or existing programs or projects that support or provide for basic human needs – food, water, shelter, hygiene supplies and essential transportation; programs that support individual and community safety and preparedness efforts, etc.)

NOT ELIGIBLE FOR FUNDING OR CONSIDERATION

- Religious organizations, programs or directly affiliated projects
- Political Parties/Campaigns and/or projects suggesting endorsement
- Endowment creation and/or debt reduction
- Capital Campaigns and/or directly related programs/projects
- Reimbursements for purchases made prior to submission of application
- Operational costs that are NOT directly related to the proposed project or program
- Salaries/Human Capital requests WILL NOT be considered

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS (TO BE SUBMITTED WITH APPLICATION)

- MOST RECENT IRS 501 (c)(3) tax determination letter
- A **CURRENT** list of your organizations Board of Directors (*with officers indicated*)
- A copy of your organization's Bylaws and procedures
- ****Previous recipients are also REQUIRED to submit these documents, without exception****

****PLEASE NOTE**** Applicants who **are not** registered as a 501(c)(3), tax-exempt organization, **may still be eligible to apply**, by using or partnering with an eligible fiscal agent/applicant. Partnerships and collaborations are **HIGHLY considered and preferred**. GRANT PROCESS TIMELINE – “What to Expect “Start-to-Finish”

- **January 13th - February 10th, @6:00pm/CST** -Applications to be submitted
 - **February 13th- February 15th**- Applicants contacted if further information is needed
 - **February 23rd - February 24th (presentation time TBD)** - Applicants to present proposals
(via Zoom)
 - **March 1st** - Grant Review Committee will meet to determine award
recommendations
 - **March 14th** - Grant Committee will present recommendations at full Board Meeting
 - **March 15th-March 17th** – Applicants will be notified of award determination
 - **March 17th- March 22nd** – Recipients to sign and submit **required** award contracts
- Funding will be dispersed to recipients, following submission of signed contracts**

FRIENDLY REMINDERS AND CONSIDERATIONS

- **LATE AND/OR INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED**
- **We encourage you (if possible) to collaborate and apply with other community partners**
- **If selected as a recipient, you will be required to complete and submit a (6) and/or (12) month progress review to report how United Way Grant funding impacted your organization**
- **If you are NOT awarded grant funding, a letter of determination with a brief explanation will be mailed or emailed to you between March 15th and March 18th**
- **There is no pre-determined, “set amount” or minimum/maximum amount that you can or should apply for – we ask that you apply for the amount you NEED**
